

Medicare Part D Changes to Know About

If you have a Medicare part D prescription drug plan and you are experiencing a medication denial, please be aware that some recent changes have occurred. Medications such as **Provigil**, **Nuvigil** and **Ritalin** are no longer covered for MS fatigue. Tranquilizers such as **Valium**, **Klonopin**, and **Tranxene** are no longer covered for any diagnosis. **Cellcept** is no longer covered for MS, and **Lyrica** is no longer covered for MS related pain. Patients requiring these drugs now have to pay out of pocket for them. If you need to change medications, please make an appointment with the doctor or nurse practitioner.
